- 1. New York has many people who come from other countries and there are so many languages. Find out how many languages are spoken in the City. Take half of this number and put in Box #1.
- 2. Clue Box #2: There are many millionaires in New York City. Take the number millionaires in the City and put this answer in box #2.
- 3. Find the year that New York City was founded. Add 200 to this number and put your answer in Box #3.
- 4. The Statue of Liberty is a fun place to visit. The Statue was not made in New York, but it was a gift from France. Take the year that the Statute was made and divide the number in half. Put this answer is Box #4.
- 5. There is a lot of snow in New York, how many times more snow than the South Pole do they get in New York? Find how much more snow and multiply by 3. Put the answer in Box #5.
- 6. New York is famous for its Broadway Theatres. People come from all over the world to see these plays. If the city doubled the number Broadway theatres, how many would they have? Put this answer in #6.
